This race is in honor of the late Tinley Park resident Tony Bettenhausen. He raced midgets winning many races on the asphalt, high-banked Mazon Speedbowl. He was a member of the "Chicago Gang" that raced at Raceway Park, Illiana, Soldier Field and many other tracks throughout the Midwest. His hard-charging style of driving made him the race fan's favorite wherever he raced. Through the 1940s, '50s and into the '60s, he continued racing midgets, sprint cars, stock cars and Indy cars. Tony Bettenhausen ran in the Indianapolis 500 fourteen times and finished in the top 10 five times.
